



- Prepare a room-by-room inventory of the contents of your home
- Check trees overhanging your property are well maintained and trimmed clear of your house
- Secure all loose items outside your property including garden furniture, umbrellas, sheds and children's cubby houses
- Check that piping and guttering are not blocked and your roof is in good condition
- Check you have comprehensive vehicle insurance. Remember that compulsory third party (CTP) does not cover you for damage to your vehicle
- Have waterproof bags ready to protect clothing and important documents from water damage
- Prepare a storm readiness kit, including a torch, radio, candles, matches, new batteries and any important documents or contact numbers
- Listen to the radio for storm updates or visit the Bureau of Meteorology website: <http://www.bom.gov.au>
- Contact your insurer to find out what is and is not included in your insurance policy, and update it if required
- If you need help from state emergency services volunteers due to a storm or flood emergency call 132 500. If in a life-threatening emergency contact triple zero (000)
